

Nature and environment are gallery's themes

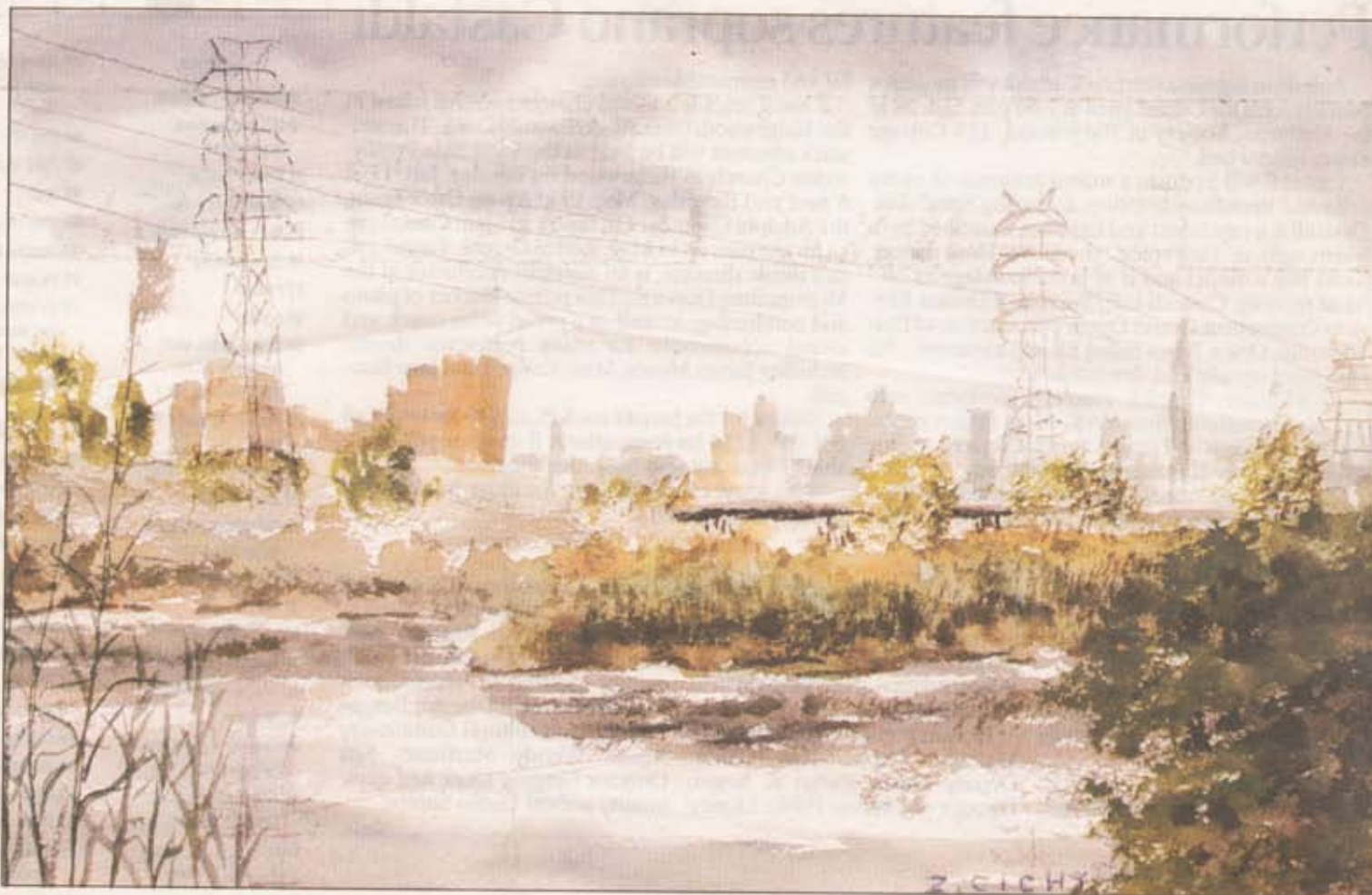
Artwork by members of the Art Association of Rutherford will be on display at the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission's Flyway Gallery this month.

The theme of the exhibit is "nature and environment," and the show runs now through Friday, Oct. 30. The show is free and open to the public from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays, and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on weekends.

The exhibit, which showcases various media, including watercolor, oils, and photography, also celebrates the Art Association of Rutherford's 62nd anniversary. The NJMC has hosted the Association's annual juried show for several years, and these exhibits have featured first-rate works by artists from the region.

The juried exhibit is the largest annual show for members of the Rutherford association, which includes professionals, hobbyists, and current and former art teachers. Members of the group meet monthly at Rutherford's Borough Hall for lectures, contests and museum excursions.
