NJMC's Business Accelerator Celebrates First Anniversary

Major strides in Helping Entrepreneurs Grow Green Businesses

LYNDHURST, N.J. – The New Jersey Meadowlands Commission’s Business Accelerator is celebrating its first anniversary this month. The Accelerator was created to help entrepreneurs focused on alternate energy as well as “green” and sustainable technologies and services grow their businesses.

“The Accelerator is a huge success already –even though they’ve been helping start-up companies for only a year,” said Robert Ceberio, Executive Director of the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission.

“Just look at the numbers,” said Ceberio. “The Accelerator employs more than 21 people full-time, and it has already trained five interns, Our clients involved have already generated nearly \$840,000 in new business, and they have attracted \$2.1 million in third-party funding.

The Oct. 15 celebration, hosted by Accelerator Director Michel Bitritto. attracted more than three dozen visitors, including several members of the Governor’s economic development staff.
