Digital Media Exhibit On Display at Flyway Gallery in July

LYNDHURST, N.J. – The evocative work of digital media artist Maria M. Walker will be on display during July at the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission’s (NJMC) Flyway Gallery. The show, “Delirium,” runs from Thursday, July 2 through Thursday, July 30. A reception for the artist is scheduled for 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Sunday, July 19.

Walker, a Carlstadt resident, experiments with digital media and photography. She describes her photographs as the foundation of her art, which she infuses with the emotional intensity, spontaneity and anti-figurative aesthetic of abstract expressionism. Walker says she considers art to be an act of rebellion, and she believes that digital media expands and redefines an artist’s creative possibilities.

The NJMC created the Flyway Gallery to help foster the cultural identity of the Meadowlands District by providing a space to showcase the talent of local artists. Recent exhibits have featured nature paintings by Fair Lawn resident David Buckbinder and North Bergen resident Lissanne Lake, photographs by Melissa Buesing and Jonathan Glick of Rutherford, and drawings of the Meadowlands by students in Hudson County’s Gifted and Talented Consortium.

The gallery is open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Admission is free.
