ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission (NJMC), One DeKorte Park Plaza, Lyndhurst, NJ, 07071 for the following:

NJMC ENTRANCE IMPROVEMENTS: Contract LA-1002

Bids will be received at the above address until 11:00 AM prevailing time, on Wednesday August 11, 2010. The Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time. Bids will not be accepted after 11:00 AM on that day.

Contract Documents may be reviewed and purchased at the NJMC offices beginning Monday, July 12, 2010, after 11:00 AM. The non-refundable document fee is \$200.00, plus shipping.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, July 21, 2010 at the NJMC Offices. Contract Documents may be obtained prior to or after the pre-bid meeting. Bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.

The Work of this Contract consists of providing all labor, equipment, materials, tools, and services necessary to construct building entrance improvements at NJMC's office complex. The work includes but is not limited to: fabrication and installation of one custom ADAAG-compliant ramp; fabrication and installation of one covered steel canopy; excavation and filling with polyurethane foam; installation of a new automatic sliding door; removal and replacement of concrete pavers; removal and replacement of concrete curbing; minor removal and replacement of asphalt paving; minor filling and grading; relocation of exterior electrical fixtures.

The Contract Time is 180 days from the start date in the Notice-to-Proceed letter.

A bid deposit, in the amount of five percent of the bid, but not exceeding \$20,000 must accompany the Bid.

The Contract Documents contain specific requirements for submission of a bid. In conformance with Public Law 1977, Chapter 33, if the bidder is a corporation or partnership, it shall submit with the bid a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders/partners who have a ten percent or greater interest in the firm.

The attention of all bidders is particularly called to the New Jersey State requirements regarding the conditions of employment to be observed. All bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, regarding Affirmative Action.


In accordance with Public Law 2001, Chapter 134, the NJMC may only enter into contracts with Bidders who provide proof of valid business registration with the Division of Revenue, Department of Treasury, State of New Jersey. The Contractor, and all subcontractors, shall attach a copy of the Division of Revenue Business Registration Certificate to Bid Form 00482. Registration information can be obtained at www.state.nj.us/treasury/revenue or by calling 609-292-1730. There is no cost to register.

In accordance with the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, the Contractor and all subcontractors shall provide, **with the Bid**, proof of compliance with NJSA 34:11-56.48 et. seq. Registration information can be obtained at www.state.nj.us/labor or by calling 609-292-9464. Forms are included at the end of Section 00100: Instructions to Bidders. No Contractor may bid on this Work unless he/she, as well as all subcontractors, is registered pursuant to this act at **the time the bid is made**.

In order to insulate the award of state contracts from risk of improper influence, the NJMC shall only enter into a Contract with a Bidder who complies with Public Law 2005, C. 51. Additionally, Bidders shall comply with Executive Order 117 which extends the provisions of Chapter 51. The required forms and instructions are available at www.state.nj.us/treasury/purchase/forms and are included at the end of Section 00100: Instructions to Bidders.
