

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission, One DeKorte Park Plaza, Lyndhurst, New Jersey 07071 for the following:

### **CONTRACT SW 10-01 FIELD SERVICES AND ANALYTICAL WORK**

Bids will be received at the above address until 11:00AM, prevailing time, on Friday, September 3, 2010. At the termination of the time for receipt of bids, the bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud. No Bids will be accepted after 11:00 AM on that day. **The primary Contractor must be the Contract laboratory.** The Contract Laboratory and the sampling company must be located within two hours driving time of the landfills.

Contract Documents will be available for review at the NJMC Offices after 1:00 PM on Wednesday, August 4, 2010. Copies of the documents may be obtained at the NJMC Offices upon payment of the \$50.00 non-refundable fee for each set. The documents do not have to be returned. The Contract Documents can also be shipped via Federal Express, or other carrier service, using the bidder's account number.

All comments regarding the Documents are due by the end of business on Friday, August 20, 2010. Responses will be mailed to all document holders by Friday, August 27, 2010. The Contract will be awarded at the September Commission meeting.

The Work of this Contract generally consists of providing all plant, labor, equipment, materials, tools, and services necessary to perform all sample collection and analyses of groundwater, leachate, and stormwater, as required to satisfy the requirements of the various NJPDES and PVSC Permits for NJMC'S four landfill sites. The sampling must be performed in accordance with all current NJDEP guidelines. All analyses must be in accordance with current NJDEP guidelines, the Site Permit Requirements, and "Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater," Current Edition.

The Contract Laboratory and all subcontracted laboratories MUST be registered to do business in the State of New Jersey, and currently certified by the NJDEP to perform the required analyses. The Contract Laboratory shall have at least five years experience performing similar analyses. A maximum of 25% of the analytical parameters may be subcontracted. The field services personnel shall have at least three years experience, and be completely familiar with all the NJDEP sampling guidelines and safety procedures.

**The Contract Time starts on November 1, 2010, and samples must be collected during that first week to fulfill Permit requirements. The Contract Time ends on October 31, 2014.**

A Bid deposit, in the amount of five percent of the bid (but not exceeding \$20,000.00) must accompany the Bid.

The Contract Documents contain specific requirements for the submission of a bid. In conformance with Public Law 1977, Chapter 33; if the bidder is a corporation or partnership, it must submit with the Bid, a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders and partners who have a ten percent or greater interest in the firm.

The attention of all bidders is particularly called to the New Jersey State requirements regarding the conditions of employment to be observed, and the requirements of Public Law 1977, Chapter 127, regarding Affirmative Action.

In accordance with Public Law 2001, Chapter 134, the NJMC may only enter into contracts with Bidders who provide proof of a valid Business Registration with the Division of Revenue, Department of Treasury, State of New Jersey. The Contractor shall attach its Division of Revenue Business Registration Certificate, and the Certificates for all the subcontractors, to Article 3.10 of Section 3.00. Registration information can be obtained on the worldwide web at [www.state.nj.us/treasury/revenue](http://www.state.nj.us/treasury/revenue) or by calling 609-292-1730. Online registration is available, and there is no cost to register.

To insulate the award of State Contracts from risk of improper influence, the NJMC may only enter into a Contract with a Bidder who complies with the requirements of Executive Order 117.
