PUBLIC NOTICE

New Jersey Meadowlands Commission Energy Master Plan

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on July 23, 2008 the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission (NJMC) released the draft NJMC Energy Master Plan for public comment.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that public hearings will be held to accept comments on this document on Tuesday, September 9, 2008, at 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. in the Commission Meeting Room at the NJMC, Two DeKorte Park Plaza, Lyndhurst, New Jersey. Each session shall extend until all comments have been heard.

The NJMC Energy Master Plan was prepared by Rutgers University Center for Energy, Economic and Environmental Policy under the direction of NJMC staff and the NJMC's Renewable Energy Task Force comprised of various stakeholders.

The goals articulated in the draft plan are consistent with the New Jersey State renewable energy polices stipulated in the New Jersey Global Warming Response Act and the New Jersey Energy Master Plan. They include:

- Goal 1: Maximize the Meadowlands District's energy conservation and energy efficiency to achieve reductions in energy consumption of at least 20 percent by 2020.
- Goal 2: Reduce Peak Demand for electricity by 2020.
- Goal 3: Install 20 MW of Renewable Energy in the Meadowlands District by 2020.
- Goal 4: Invest in innovative clean energy technologies and businesses to stimulate the industry's growth in the Meadowlands District.


