PUBLIC NOTICE

SP-590 Prohibition Against Improper Influence Proposed New Rules N.J.A.C. 19:4-4.23

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission (NJMC) is proposing to adopt a new rule regarding the prohibition against improper influence, at N.J.A.C. 19:4-4.23. The proposed regulation will appear in the December 17, 2007 New Jersey Register.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing on this matter will be held on Tuesday, January 8, 2008, at 10:00 A.M. in the Office of the Commission, One DeKorte Park Plaza, Lyndhurst, New Jersey.

Specifically, N.J.A.C. 19:4-4.23 is proposed as a new rule. The following is a summary of the matter:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:17-6(i), the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission (NJMC) proposes to adopt a new rule at N.J.A.C. 19:4-4.23.

The NJMC staff was authorized by the NJMC Board of Commissioners on September 19, 2007, to proceed with this proposed rulemaking in order to ensure that the NJMC has a mechanism in place to ensure that its procedures for regulating development are carried out in accordance with the most stringent ethical standards legally available.

This statement is intended only as a summary of the proposed rules. Please refer to the full text of the proposal as published in the New Jersey Register for details of the proposed rule amendments.
